Student Requirements and Expectations on AMI Days

Through Act 862 of 2017 the Poyen School District was approved for five Alternate Methods of Instruction (AMI) Days to be used if we miss a school day due to snow or ice. The day(s) missed will not have to be made up at the end of the year, on Saturdays, or by adding time to the school day. Students will be required to complete assignments at home during an AMI day. Teachers will post assignments to Google Classroom or provide paper copies to students that have limited or no internet access at home. Students must complete and turn in the assignments by the end of the third school day following an AMI day. Failure to do so will result in a zero for the assignment and the student will be marked absent for the AMI day.

Teachers will discuss student's expectations and requirements for AMI days with each student. They will also be sending home paper copies of assignment for K-2nd grade and students that have limited or no internet access at home. Students will keep the paper copies at home to complete only if an AMI day is used. Teachers will post assignments to Google Classroom by 9:00 a.m. for students with home internet access. Teachers will be available for questions by email, Google Classroom, and in elementary Class Dojo during an AMI day.
